Greetings in the Mighty Name of Jesus!

We would like to introduce you to the International School of Ministry™ (ISOM). ISOM is a church-based DVD/USB video training program. It was developed to assist pastors as they disciple and equip Christians to be laborers in the end-time harvest. The 160 lessons included in the curriculum have the potential to bring great blessing and growth in your church and transform the lives of those you are training.

The ISOM materials are available in many different languages. In Central and East Africa, there are schools studying in English, Swahili, French, and Portuguese. In many different places, in different cultures, in cities and in villages, the many existing schools demonstrate the ongoing effectiveness of this ministry in discipling church leaders.

The objective of ISOM is to provide training and discipleship for leaders and all believers. ISOM is NOT a denomination. ISOM does NOT credential pastors nor guarantee pastoral appointment. ISOM is only a discipleship tool to be used to further the Kingdom of God within each local church. ISOM encourages pastors to include their own teaching alongside, or in addition to, the courses delivered via DVD/USB.

This Introductory Packet will assist you in starting an ISOM training center in your area. Each center must have a Facilitator. The Facilitator will lead the school and have many administrative responsibilities. Therefore, he or she should be a trustworthy person. No one is paid by ISOM to lead a school. Before a person agrees to be the Facilitator, he or she should consider the responsibilities and the cost involved.

To start an ISOM training center, the Facilitator must complete and send the School Application included in this packet to Pamoja Ministries. (The information can be sent by e-mail if desired.) A list of registered students (at least 10) and the tuition fees for the first Trimester must be included with the application. After we receive your application, fees & list of students, we will send you the materials for the school. We will include a Facilitator's Guide to help the Facilitator organize the school. 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School Application Instructions

REQUIRED FEES

Tuition Fees: Each student must pay the equivalent of \$15 US for the first trimester when they sign up for the School. This fee must be paid before the Facilitator will be given the materials for the course. Each student must also pay the equivalent of \$15 US for each subsequent trimester of study. (It may be possible to obtain help for a student if there are specific unusual circumstances.)

Be aware that there are 160 lessons required to complete ISOM. If you study one lesson per week, it will required roughly 4 years to complete. If you study 3 lessons per week you can finish the 96 lessons required for the Certificate in one year. You can finish the remaining 64 lessons for the Diploma in a half year. Each school can choose how many times to meet each week.

The Facilitator needs to be aware that there will be additional costs related to the school such as Postal Money Orders to submit the fees and postage to mail the exams to Kahawa Media.

COMMUNICATION

Please print all required information clearly on the School Application. To facilitate communication with the ISOM Administrator, please list an e-mail address and/or cell phone number (for SMS messages) where you can be contacted.

LIST OF REGISTERED STUDENTS

As prospective students indicate their desire to attend, have them clearly print their name on a list and collect the fee for the first trimester. You must register a minimum of 10 students to start a school. Make sure that each student's name is printed exactly as they wish it to appear on their Certificate. Each student must use the same names, in the same order, for all ISOM courses in order to properly receive credit. If the Facilitator will also be a student, he/she must include his/her name on the list of registered students. Please note beside the name that this person is the Facilitator.

If there is a need to start a school with fewer than 10 students, please contact the ISOM Administrator at *Kahawa Media* to discuss special arrangements.

MATERIALS WE WILL SEND

When you submit your payment for the first trimester, we will send you the following materials from our office:

1. We will send the Facilitator's Guide, to lead you through the steps required to run a school.
2. We will send the DVDs/USB drive for the first 32 hours of training (trimester 1)
3. Each student will receive notes for the first trimester in the language requested.

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4. We will send the Facilitator the required tests for each student.
5. If the Facilitator is not also a student, we will send the answer key for marking the tests.
6. We will obtain and send Certificates and Diplomas for each student when they complete the required tests.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

You need a TV and DVD player or the ability to watch a video from USB to view the ISOM courses.

CHOOSING THE LOCATION

The courses can be taught in almost any location. A church, a home large enough to accommodate the class, a business with a meeting room, or even an outdoor patio is entirely acceptable. Choose a location that will be readily available for the duration of the trimester. When choosing a location, consider seating for the students and the availability of electricity for the equipment.
